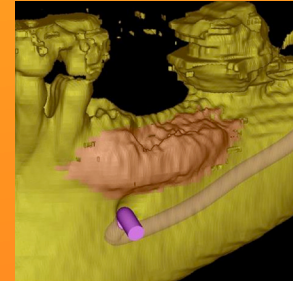
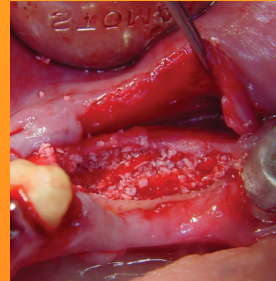
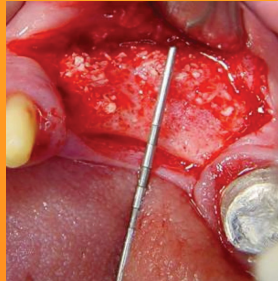

Dr. Marius Steigmann

Dr. Steigmann holds numerous academic appointments at universities in the United States and Europe, including positions in the Department of Periodontics at University of Michigan, the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at the Boston University, the Department of Endodontics at the University of Pennsylvania, Carol Davila University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Bucharest, and the University of Szeged in Hungary.

Dr. Steigmann is a member of several professional associations, including the DGOI, FIZ, BDIZ, and ICOI. He also earned a PhD from the University of Neumarkt.

He is the founder and Scientific President of Update Implantologie, as well as founder and director of the Steigmann Institute, where he teaches educational courses focused on soft tissue management in dental implant therapy. Dr. Steigmann has published extensively and lectures around the world.

About Module 2

Esthetics in implant dentistry will be the focus of this course. In the past, a general tendency was to mimic/copy teeth with implants functionally and esthetically. The same surgical techniques from oral surgery or periodontology were used in implant surgery; however, they were esthetically unsuccessful. By determining new incision position, depth, and angulation according to the interproximal bone and soft tissue biotype, we change the way we do aesthetic implant surgery today. Also, new incision flap designs and suturing techniques have been developed or adjusted to address the esthetic needs around implants and avoid or correct failures in the aesthetic zone. Techniques to preserve the soft tissue and repair soft tissue failures around an implant will be taught.

 - for soft tissue improvement
 - for creating keratinized gingiva
 - for gaining soft tissue elasticity
- Learn about EBF aesthetic buccal flap, roll flap, pedicular flap and soft tissue uncovering techniques
- Learn about advanced suturing techniques

The achievement of optimal esthetics around anterior dental implants has been a major challenge for many clinicians. The key to an esthetically pleasing appearance lies in the clinician's ability to manage properly the soft tissue profile around dental implants.

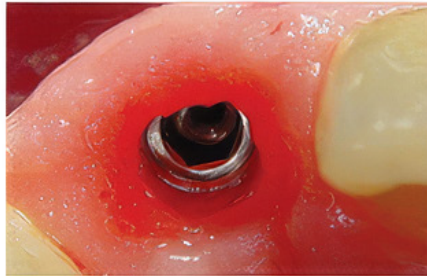
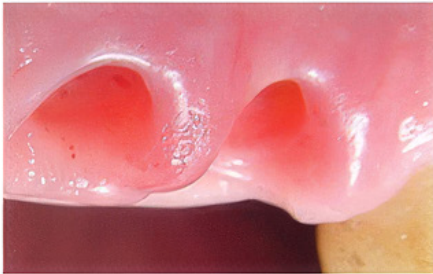
